GENERAL INFORMATION:

Prepared by the emulsion copolymerization of acrylonitrile and butadiene. Acrylonitrile-butadiene rubbers can be compounded and processed in much the same manner as natural rubber; they may be vulcanized with either conventional sulphur systems or peroxides. Acrylonitrile-butadiene rubbers are highly resistant toward non-polar solvents such as fuels and oil. They find applications as gaskets, fuel hoses, oil seals, o-rings, adhesives and in blends with thermosetting resins.

STRUCTURE:
